

Brian also serves as an executive coach for MBA candidates at Arizona State University's WP Carey School of Business.

Brian's business and career trajectory culminated most recently as EVP & CHRO at JDA. During his 14-year tenure, Brian held a position on the Executive Committee, steering the company's growth from a revenue of \$200 million to over \$1 billion. Brian's responsibility included all human capital matters for the company's global operations, including total rewards, M&A, organizational excellence, leadership and talent development and change management.

In previous roles, Brian served as CHRO and SVP Legal Affairs at ASARCO Incorporated, a Fortune 500 metals producer. Over 16 years, he held diverse leadership positions within ASARCO, including operational roles with P&L responsibilities, managing over 1,000 employees and operating budgets exceeding \$100 million.
